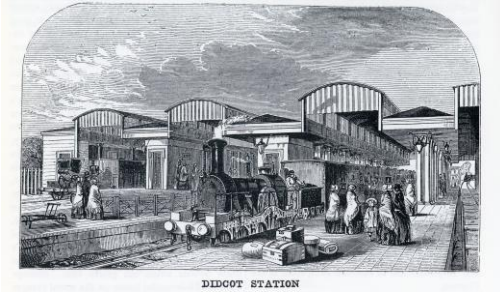
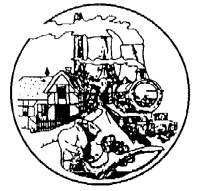


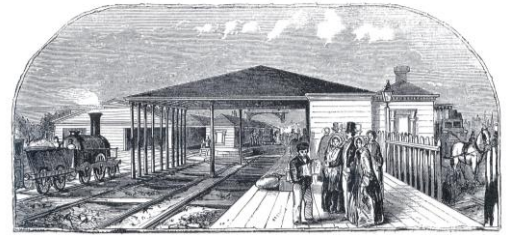

THE OPENING OF THE RAILWAY FROM DIDCOT TO OXFORD

June 2019 is the 175th anniversary of the Didcot to Oxford Branch of the Great Western Railway. The opening of the line to the public on 12 June caused enormous excitement.

To commemorate this pivotal part of Didcot's history, we are mounting an exhibition in the Study at Cornerstone, from 27 May - 17 June 2019.
